CLEAN International: 2024 Annual Impact Report Advancing Global Water Access, Resilience, and Innovation

In 2024, CLEAN International continued its mission to protect and provide water worldwide through collaboration, innovation, and community action. From restoring lakes and installing rainwater harvesting systems to expanding education and deploying smart technologies, CLEAN worked alongside local partners to strengthen water resilience and improve lives across multiple continents. Guided by a shared vision of sustainability, our global network of partners, schools, and volunteers came together to create lasting, measurable impact—proving once again that when we unite for water, we create change that flows far beyond a single community.



NEW WELLS

In Togo, more than 3,000 people across six communities and one hospital now have access to clean, reliable water from a new well.



RAINWATER HARVESTING

In Tanzania, Phase 1 of the Uzima Garden initiative launched in 2024 in partnership with Cornell University and Engineers Without Borders.



RAINWATER HARVESTING

CLEAN's 2024 collaboration with Gravity Water and the Environmental Ethics Foundation of Taiwan (EEFT) brought rainwater harvesting systems to schools in Taiwan, Nepal, and Vietnam, expanding access to clean water and environmental education. [Video Link](#)



WELL RESTORATION

In India, the third year of our well restoration initiative has brought new life to centuries-old wells, revitalizing water sources and supporting communities in need.



WATER SAVING TECH & EDUCATION

In Malaysia, 100 schools across Penang are now equipped with water-saving auto shut-off faucets, and thousands of students have gained hands-on education about water conservation. A special thank-you to our local partner, Water Watch Penang, for making this impact possible!



PURIFICATION TABLETS FOR DISASTER RELIEF

In 2024, CLEAN partnered with Direct Relief to distribute more than 100,000 water purification tablets to communities impacted by disasters across the United States.



WELL AND RAINWATER HARVESTING

In Sierra Leone, a new well and rainwater harvesting system at a professional development and primary school are now providing students and staff with reliable access to clean water year-round.





LAKE RESTORATION

Together with SayTrees and our global partners, more than 20 lakes across India were restored by the end of 2024. This collective effort is part of our shared goal to rejuvenate 300 lakes throughout India by 2030.

VOLUNTEERS, MAKE A MOVE & TREE PLANTING

In 2024, hundreds of volunteers across the globe planted 35,000+ trees and plants, cleaned up waterways, and learned how to protect water for future generations. Thank you for helping make a global impact!





WATER FILTERS

Since 2015, CLEAN International has partnered with Wachalal Medical Clinic in rural Guatemala to provide families affected by waterborne illness with clean water filters. By the end of 2024, more than 12,000 people now have access to safe, sustainable drinking water. One-year-old Emili (pictured) was ill before her family received their Ecofiltro—today, she's healthy and thriving!

Utilizing Innovation to Strengthen Water Resilience

CLEAN is leveraging smart technology across projects — from lake restoration and rainwater harvesting systems to water utility management — to strengthen water resilience worldwide. Our work focuses on the world's 100 priority basins, advancing monitoring systems, supporting flood and drought prevention, and identifying scalable solutions and partnerships for long-term water sustainability.
